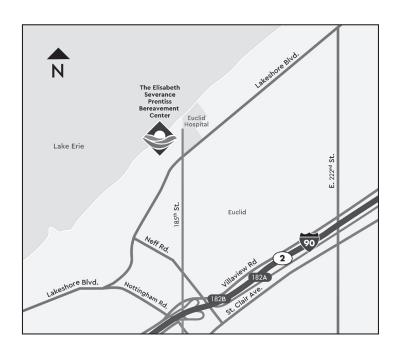

Healing Arts Workshops provide grieving people with a creative outlet for their grief and are open to the community. No art experience is necessary.

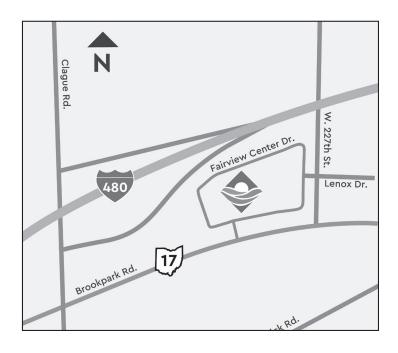




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
